Wrightwood is called the “Land of Four Seasons” — and with good reason. You’ll find plenty to do in this beautiful alpine village, from skiing in the winter, to mountain biking and hiking during the summer. What’s best? There are no jaw-dropping cliffs or winding roads to get here.

Travel Tips

- Buy the \$5 Adventure Pass. If not, you’re looking at a \$150 fine.
- Carry chains in the winter, and pull completely off the road before installing them.
- Don’t traverse local neighborhoods hoping to beat winter traffic to Mountain High. There’s no outlet and you’ll be an hour behind schedule.
- Save money, pack a picnic. Deli items can be purchased at Jensen’s Market.
- Always bring water, mirror (for reflection), black trash bag (for warmth) and whistle on a hike. They could save your life.
